“It was cool because we got to get up and play instruments” Keira

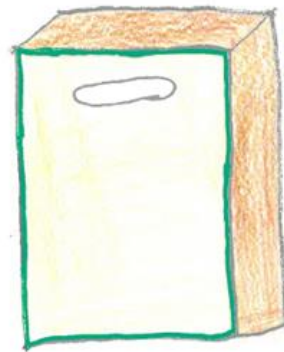
“I love the guitar and the way he used the pedal” Nate
