

Respectful Schools Agreement



Adults in our school:

- Treat everyone as equal
- Share responsibility for children's learning and wellbeing
- Are positive role models to the kids
- Keep personal conflict away from the school environment
- Use appropriate tone and language
- Remain rational and non-threatening
- Do not use Social Media forums for posting inappropriate comments about the school, staff, students or families
- Are prepared for each school day and get their kids to school on time
- Understand regular attendance is important
- Take responsibility for their child's home reading
- Supervise children to and from school
- Ensure safe driving in and around the school
- Understand classrooms are busy and request a time to talk about concerns
- Receive regular feedback from teachers on positive behaviour
- Are greeted and welcomed with respect
- Are safe in the knowledge that matters will be dealt with confidentially
