1:00pm – Meet in your child's classroom and sign in before moving outside.

Activities - Join in your child's class activity. Families with more than one child may divide their time between classes but children will need to stay in their class groups. Activities will run for approximately 40 minutes.

Food Tasting – Made by students in our kitchen garden program from fresh garden produce. Stay with the class to share food platters and sample some of the great work that is happening in our kitchen garden program. This will be just a **taste**. Children will have lunch beforehand.

Performances – Enjoy performances by our school choir, recorder group and Prep I P.

Official Opening – At 2.20 the outdoor learning area will be officially launched. Students will then move back to their classes for dismissal.
