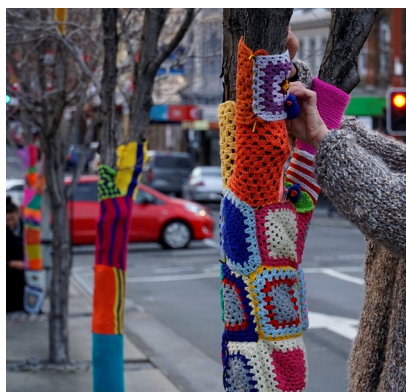

**Knit or crotchet squares approximately
20cm x 20cm OR 40cm x 40cm OR pom-poms**

Required by mid-May

Information

Thank you for participating in the 2019 Yarn Bomb at the Royal Hobart Hospital.

After a very successful yarn bomb in 2018 and many requests to continue, this year we will knit for the same trees in Liverpool Street outside of the hospital but we also hope to yarn bomb all of the trees in Franklin Square.

Pattern:

- Acrylic wool only
- Bright coloured yarn if possible as it looks really effective but any colour is fine
- If you are using 8ply acrylic you will need around 35 stitches to make a 20cm wide square
- You could also knit 20cm wide **but as long as you like**
- Or if you prefer something bigger knit or crotchet squares of 40 x 40cms.

Non-knitters:

Make pom-poms of any size or colour.

Creative people:

You may like to knit something creative for our trees. Last year one lady knitted 21 blue birds and a local artist knitted 30 brightly coloured mushrooms. Give me a call. Let me know what you would like to do.

When is it required:

We need your knitted items by mid-May. We will sew them together to fit the trees ready for installation on the 11th of June 2019.
