

Booking into events at Rosny Library

We use Eventbrite for bookings for all of our events. You can use any device or computer, at any time of the day (or night!). Or we can book you in. You will get an email confirmation from Eventbrite for all bookings.

Note: Eventbrite asks you to activate your account. This is optional. It is useful for tracking all the events you are booked into, and if you want to use the app, but it is not necessary.

DIY using Eventbrite (available 24/7)

1. Go to www.eventbrite.com.au and type 'Rosny Library' into the search bar
2. Click on the event and Click on 'register'
3. Fill in your details and click submit
